Invitation to Giving: Wassmuth Center for Human Rights and the Anne Frank Memorial

Andrew Kukla (First, Boise) extends this invitation:

I know... you don't need one more project to support. You don't need one more thing to do.... please bear with me a second – if only for whatever trust I may have earned with you in our past work. Or just send me a text or call and say: what do you need Andrew! The Wassmuth Center exists to lift up that Idaho is not a place of extremist hate, White Nationalism, and Christian Exceptionalism. Those things are here. But that does not tell the longer story... the fuller story. So it is here in the heart of Boise a gem in the Gem State– that we have the Anne Frank Memorial and a witness to the long history of Idaho as a place that honors the human dignity of all people... while also telling the stories that say otherwise in hopes that we do not repeat the worst of our past and correct the worst of our present moment.

The Wassmuth Center is building a new building and in front of that building will be four "rocks" of human rights. One of them will say "Respect" and it will be sponsored by "Boise Interfaith Communities".

That is what I'm writing to you about. An interfaith effort across all our lines and divides to stand up and say we all value respect for one another and the work of uplifting hope on behalf of those who have been marginalized and othered. Those for whom there have been no refuge. I am committed to raising \$50,000 toward that effort and I am hoping that you personally – and possible the faith community you call home – will help to sponsor this project. Already over a dozen individuals and four faith communities have joined us including First Presbyterian – Boise, Hyde Park Mennonite, Collister United Methodist, and Boise Unitarian Universalist Fellowship. We have a little over \$10,000 collected and now we need to grow that effort.
